<i>Palm Sunday</i>	<i>Blessed is the King who comes in the Name of the Lord. Peace in heaven and glory in the highest.</i>	Today begins Holy Week. Let us pray that we—as individuals, families, & a congregation—will follow Jesus on the way of the cross, knowing it to be the way of eternal life.
<i>Monday in Holy Week</i>	Let's pray for each other as we seek to invite friends & neighbors to our Holy Week & Easter services. May the good news of the death & resurrection of Jesus shine forth!	Pray that we all will be committed to the core values of Trinity Church—the power of the gospel, the priority of the church, & the place where God has called us.
<i>Tuesday in Holy Week</i>	Pray for all our missionaries—in the metro area, across North America, & around the world—as they begin a new week of ministry. Pray especially for the Whites, our missionaries of the week, and their ministry in Harlem.	The gospel is the proclamation that the crucified & risen Jesus is the Messiah of Israel, the true king of the nations, the Son of God, & the Savior of the world. May we have confidence in the gospel's power as we tell our neighbors & the nations the good news.
<i>Wednesday in Holy Week</i>	Pray for patience, wisdom, & for a mission-driven vision as we continue to seek a more permanent worship facility.	Pray that Trinity Church will always be a welcoming community, providing an open door to everyone in the name of Christ.
<i>Maundy Thursday</i>	Today we celebrate Jesus' gift to us of the sacrament of Holy Communion. Thank the Father for this unique & powerful blessing.	Ask the Father to keep us committed to the priority of the church—that we would be a sign, an instrument, & a foretaste of Jesus' kingdom of love & peace.
<i>GOOD FRIDAY</i>	Jesus gave his life on the cross for the life of the world. Pray that we as a church would always die to self-interest & commit ourselves to loving our communities in the Name of Christ.	Geography is not an accident! God has called us to this place—to the New York City metropolitan region & to our suburban communities. Pray that we will be a genuine blessing as we love where God has placed us.
<i>Holy Saturday / EASTER EVE</i>	Pray for those whom you have invited to church this Easter; may their lives be changed by the resurrection power of Jesus.
